

## Instructions to Registrars for Naming Mandates

All .swiss domain names belonging to a mandate must be distinguished from conventional names .swiss domain names.

To submit the applications for domain names belonging to a mandate, proceed as follows for each domain names belonging to the mandate, using either EPP or the Registry Control Panel:

1. Set the "intended-use" field to the following character string: "mandate-" followed by the mandate's **lead domain** name ending in ".swiss".
2. Use the "mandate-domains" Phase;
3. Check that the Registrant Contact's Organization matches the Mandate Holder;
4. Check that the Registrant Contact's Enterprise ID field matches the Mandate Holder's UID (format CHE-xxx.xxx.xxx).

In the following examples, the **domain names** "flowers.swiss" and "tulips.swiss" must be registered. These belong to the naming mandate "flowers.swiss". The mandate's **lead domain** is "flowers.swiss".

Example: Application for "flowers.swiss":	
Launch phase	mandate-domains
Domain name	flowers.swiss
Intended-use field	mandate-flowers.swiss

Example: Application for "tulips.swiss":	
Launch phase	mandate-domains
Domain name	tulips.swiss
Intended-use field	mandate-flowers.swiss
